NYC Mid Express

This year, the NYC Naval Academy Parents' Club will be operating the Mid Express round trip between the Naval Academy and NYC for Thanksgiving Leave and a return trip to the Naval Academy after New Year's. There will be only one drop off and pickup location which will help save you time, money and stress.

Your Mid can ride in comfort and you avoid the heavy holiday traffic. It is also a perfect way for you to host Mids who have been invited to stay with you when their families are so far away.

The bus will depart Alumni Hall at 2 p.m. after all classes have finished on November 22. It will proceed directly to 31st Street and 7th Avenue (NY Penn Station) in Manhattan. This will allow any Mids who need to continue travel to Long Island, New Jersey, Westchester, Upstate New York, Connecticut and beyond, to connect at Penn Station, Grand Central or the Port Authority Bus Terminal.

Bus returns will depart on November 26 and in January (date to be finalized) in time to make Brigade Reform. These buses will leave from 31st Street and 7th Avenue in Manhattan and travel directly to the United States Naval Academy in Annapolis. These buses will depart at noon.

Book early to save money and make sure your Midshipman gets a seat. No refunds will be given.
